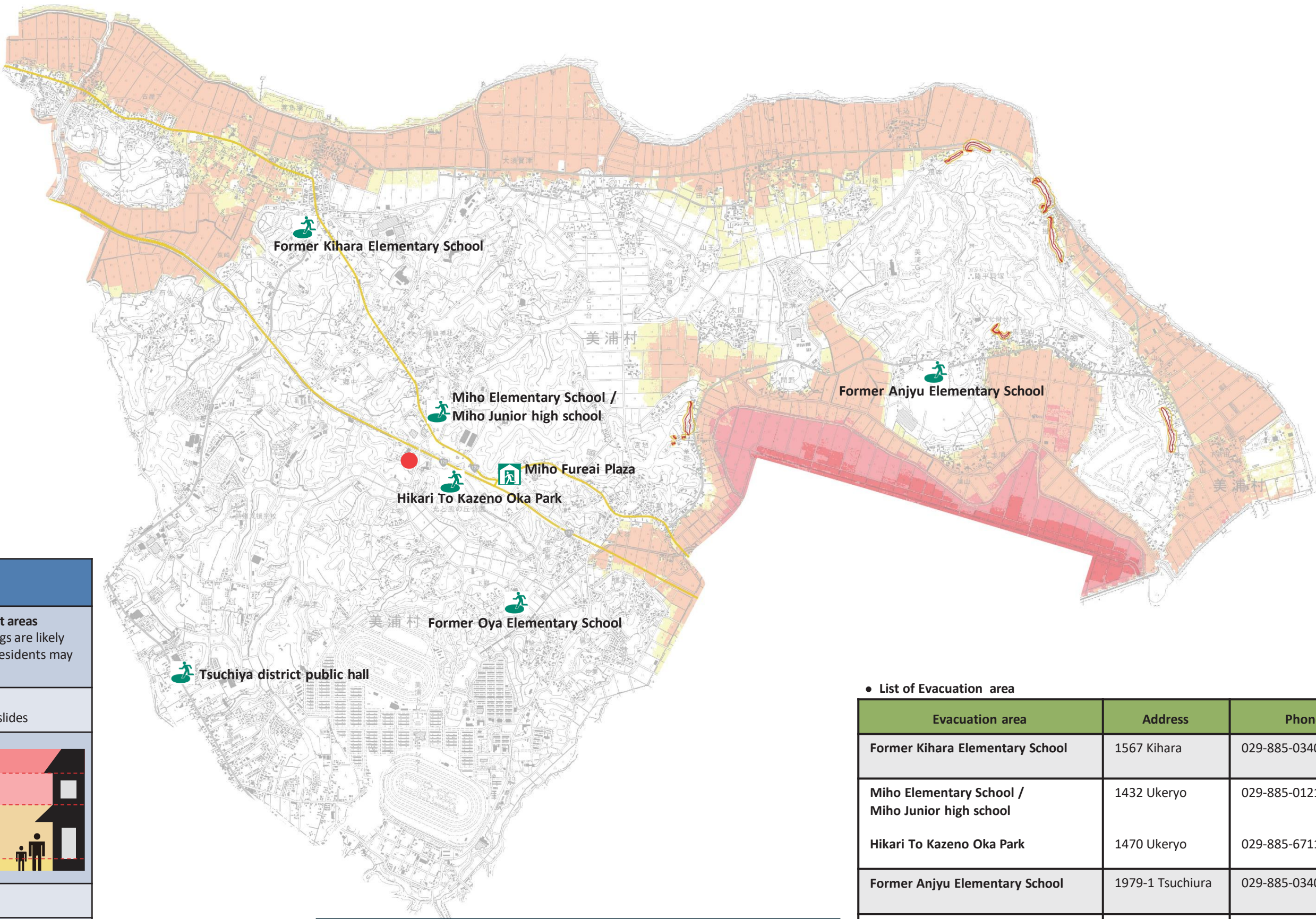
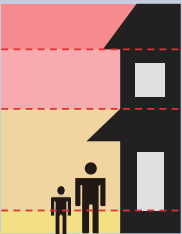


Miho Village

Flood /Landslide disaster hazard map

This map shows areas that may be inundated in the event of heavy rainfall that greatly exceeds the drainage capacity of sewers and rivers, and areas that may be damaged in the event of cliff collapses caused by rain or earthquakes. The map shows areas where flooding and landslides are expected to occur, as well as evacuation sites.

This map shows the results of a simulation of areas that would be inundated and the depth of the inundation in the event of the largest possible rainfall, as well as the special landslide hazard warning areas and landslide hazard warning areas designated by Ibaraki Prefecture.

Residents of Miho Village are requested to always keep in mind the possibility of disasters and be prepared on a daily basis by stockpiling daily necessities and understanding evacuation routes and evacuation sites. Please check this map for flooding and landslide conditions around your home.

Alert levels and evacuation information

Evacuation information will be announced at five warning levels. Take appropriate evacuation actions according to the alert level to protect yourself from wind, flood, and landslide disasters.

Alert level	Conditions	Weather information (Heavy rain , Landslide)	River Flood Forecast	Evacuation information	Action to take
5	Disaster occurring or imminent	Level 5 Emergency Warning		Emergency Safety Measures	Danger to life. Take immedate safety measures!
4	High possibility of disaster	Level 4 Urgent Warning		Evacuation Instruction	Total evacuation from dangerous areas.
3	There is a possibility of disaster	Level 3 Warning		Evacuation of the Elderly, Etc.	Evacuation of the elderly, etc., from dangerous areas.
2	Worsening weather condtions	Level 2 Advisory			Check what evacuation actions to take.
1	Possibility of worsening weather condtions	Level 1 Early Warning Information			Increase disaster preparedness.
